Parking is available on Spital Lane, Cemetery Road and along Lime Tree Avenue just inside the top entrance.

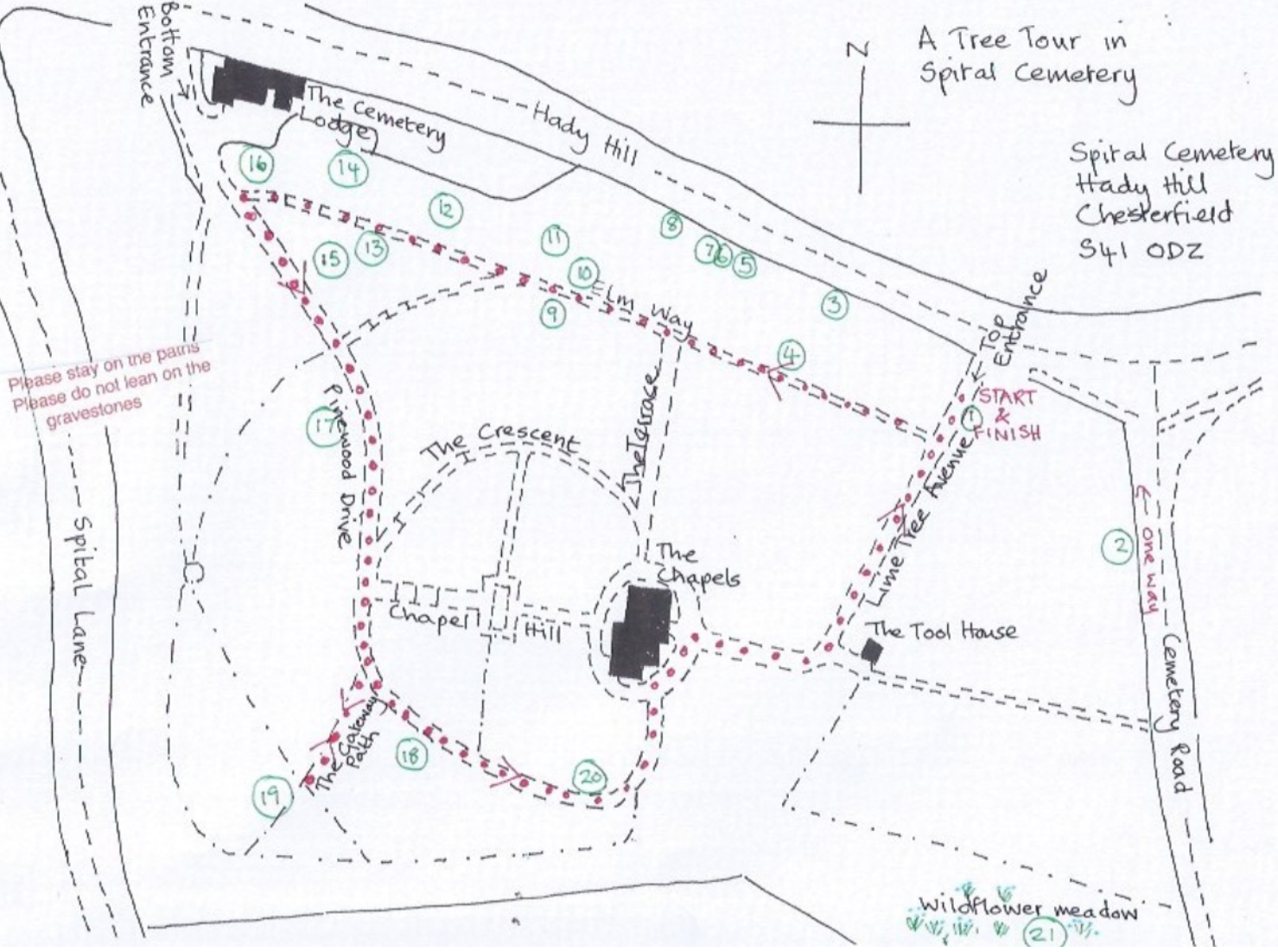
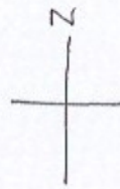
The nearest public toilets are at Chesterfield Railway Station.
